



Toddlers at Kindernook

The Kindernook Toddler Program is a once a week, two-hour program designed to be a "first experience" for most toddlers.

Through this program we will introduce children to a group setting in a warm, loving and secure environment.

Children will be provided opportunities to explore the classroom and interact with materials that allow them to explore, experiment and play. Teachers will have a variety of activities in each of the centers which the children can play with alone, in small groups and with our without a teacher facilitator.

Centers include: library, sensory table, dramatic play, math and science, art, and block play. Children will also participate in a teacher led circle time. During this time children will sing a song, listen to stories, play a group game and interact with one another.

The class will also enjoy the outdoors during the morning. The outdoor play space will allow children to run, slide, climb and dig in the sand. Children can explore the water area and watch water splash on the rocks or fill buckets to use in the sand box. When unable to go outside due to weather there is an indoor area where children can have indoor recess with large motor play using scooters, parachutes, balls and more!

Over the school year the toddlers will grow so much! We are committed to providing your child a warm and secure learning environment. We look forward to learning with your child!
