Music notes:

Mothering God You Gave Me Birth is an adaptation by Jean Janzen (1933-present) of musings by Julian of Norwich (1342-1416), whose life fell entirely during the "Hundred Years War." According to Janzen's study of Julian of Norwich, 'Julian saw Christ as our "true mother," saying, "The human mother will suckle her child with her own milk, but our beloved Mother, Jesus, feeds us with himself."'

On Mother's Day we also remember the mothering figures who are no longer with us. John Lennon wrote *Julia* about his mother who was killed in a car crash when he was 17 years old. Having been raised by his aunt for much of his life after his parents split at age five, the song's lyrics and musical style reflect a childhood he didn't have with his mother, though they reconnected in his teens. It was written in India when Lennon was studying transcendental meditation and many of the Beatles' more nuanced and profound lyrics were penned.
